

REGATTA REGULATIONS

I. DATE AND PLACE

- 1. The regatta will be held on boats of the 1x (scull) type, on September 12, 2021 in Mielno near Grunwald, on Lake Mielno, over a distance of 14 km, from a flying start. Along the route: the Krokodyl Center the largest island the Krokodyl Center.
- 2. The place embarkation on the water are the piers along the Krokodyl Center on the right bank of Lake Mielno. The logistics base of the regatta is located at the marina of Ośrodek Krokodyl Mielno 30a, 14-107 Mielno.

III. RULES OF CONDUCTING THE REGATTA

- 1. Grunwald Regatta will be held in the HEAD system with divisions.
- 2. In the regatta, the competitors will be divided into the following categories:
- Open Men / Women (senior, academic, master, amateur and youth competitors) *
- Open Men / Women (senior, academic, master, amateur and youth competitors) *
- For a given category to be included, a minimum of 6 applications is required.
- 3. The allocation into divisions will be made by the organizer after the deadline for applications.
- 4. All competitors must be in the starting area 15 minutes before the start of their division.
- 5. Competitors in the start area must face the direction of the start. Warming up in the starting area is prohibited. Competitors start approximately 3 minutes apart, according to the assigned starting numbers.
- 6. A competitor that does not start in line with his/her number may be allowed to start by the judge's discretion at the end of his/her division. Such a competitor will be penalized with a time penalty of 30 seconds.
- 7. Competitors must obey the signs posted on the route by the organizer. The final choice of course is up to the competitor. However, it is not allowed to enter beyond the safety zones marked by the



organizer. A detailed description of the route will be posted on the website and delivered to the competitors during the technical briefing on September 12, 2021.

- 8. The starting number of the competitor must be visible at all times during the race the number on the competitor's back and on the bow of the boat.
- 9. Overtaking is only allowed safely. The overtaking competitor must be sure that the maneuver is safe, the overtaken competitor has no right to obstruct the maneuver in any way. All competitors are obliged to avoid collisions.
- 10. A competitor that commits a false start is penalized with a 1-minute penalty (the judge adds 1 minute to the time obtained by the competitor).
- 11. After the start, the competitors using the boats provided by the organizer are obliged to approach the designated pier immediately after the end of the race.
- 12. The organizer reserves the right to change the route, and in particular to shorten it, if it is determined that there is a risk of danger to the competitors. This also applies to the transfer from/to individual divisions.
- 13. Each participant of the regatta by starting certifies that there are no health constraints to participate in the regatta. Minors are required to present a certificate signed by their parents or legal guardians.
- 14. Competitors taking part in the regatta agree to publish their picture for promotional purposes of the regatta and the regatta partners.
- 15. A start in the regatta is tantamount to accepting the regulations of the regatta.

IV. RULES OF PARTICIPATION

- 1. The classification will be made in 2 categories:
- Open Men / Women (senior, academic, master, amateur and youth competitors) *
- Open Men / Women (senior, academic, master, amateur and youth competitors) *
- For a given category to be included, a minimum of 6 applications is required.
- 2. In order to submit the application, please complete the application form on the website *www.grunwaldregatta.pl* and pay the registration fee by bank transfer in the amount of **PLN 50** (Polish competitors) and **EUR 15** (foreign competitors)

- 3. The deadline for initial applications is August 28, 2021
- 4. The competitors cover the costs of their stay on their own. If two nights are booked: from Friday to Sunday, competitors and their accompanying guests receive a 20% discount.
- 5. Competitors who do not have their own boat can use boats provided by the organizer.

The cost of such a service is PLN 500 / EUR 125 for a carbon scull or PLN 200 / EUR 50 for a wooden scull

- 6. A competitor who makes his own boat available for use by another competitor is exempt from the registration fee. A fee will also be paid to this player from the settlement of the boats hired to competitors.
- 7. Protests may be submitted to the organizers within 3 days after the end of the regatta.
- 8. The organizer bears the costs of insurance of the event and of the competitors' accident insurance up to an amount of PLN 10.000.



V. AWARDS

- 1. Awards are given in the following categories: Open for Men and Open for Women.
- 2. The condition for awarding the prize in a given category is the start of at least six competitors.
- 3. In addition to the medals during the Grunwald Regatta, in both categories, cash prizes are awarded in the amount of: 1st place PLN 1,500, 2nd place PLN 1,000, 3rd place PLN 500
